Project Description:

SANITARY: PLA was awarded a renewable contract in 2012 to perform landscape pre-construction and post-construction reviews of both residential and commercial properties expected to have landscape materials (*including fully mature urban trees*) damaged, removed or both as a result of sanitary sewer line replacements as required by the 2011 EPA consent decree for the City of Lexington, KY. The scope of work also included meeting with and preparing replacement estimates for property owners, negotiating reasonable replacement costs, and delivering release forms and reimbursement checks.

PLA was the first and only landscape architecture firm offering in-house arboricultural services contracted to perform this work. At present PLA has conducted evaluations & appraisals for 3 of the 5 projects – the remaining 2 being primarily within open space.

STORM: Since January 1, 2014 PLA has been awarded 2 separate contracts to provide evaluations & appraisals for stormwater sewer line replacements similar to those of sanitary. Presently only 2 landscape evaluation projects have been awarded.
