

Project Description:

PLA volunteered its design and technical services, as well as love for trees, to help promote 100 of Lexington's wonderful trees at historic Woodland Park. The "tree trail" as it has been called for many years is a collection of over 125 different species and/or cultivars of trees that can be grown in the Bluegrass region of Kentucky. The intention of the signs is to help further educate the public on the vast variety of trees available to property owners in an attempt to steer them away from planting the same species of tree on every property over and over again. This project promotes tree species diversity and helps to end the potentially devastating monoculture stands of trees such as the American Elm which was devastated by the Dutch Elm Disease.

PLA is currently working to help develop kiosks which will aid in tying all of the tree trail identification signs together.

Portions of this project are still in the process of being implemented.
